Student/Faculty

- Connections based on research or teaching interests
- Assistance with navigating academia
- Provide research and teaching support
- Progress-specific guidance (e.g., first-year student versus doctoral candidate)

Pre-Tenured/Tenured

- Connections based on research or teaching interests
- Assistance with navigating pre-tenure process
- Provide research, teaching, and service support

What the Mentorship Committee will do for the matches:

- Provide expectations around communication and goals
- Offer suggested themes and deliverables for virtual meetings and phone calls
- Send reminder emails to connect with matches
- Highlight the work and accomplishments of matches

Program timeline: August 2020 - 2021

- We are asking all mentors participating in this program for a **minimum \$20 annual donation** to the Benjamin Steiner fund to help promote continued student awards and scholarships.
- Mentors/Mentees are expected to **meet virtually at least once per month**
- Mentors/Mentees are encouraged to stay in touch and collaborate after the "official" program ends
