#### **Student/Faculty**

- Assistance with navigating academia
- Provide research and teaching support
- Progress-specific guidance (e.g., first-year student versus doctoral candidate)

#### **Pre-Tenured/Tenured**

- Connections based on research or teaching interests
- Assistance with navigating pretenure process
- Provide research, teaching, and service support

## What the Mentorship Committee will do for the matches:

- Provide expectations around communication and goals
- Offer suggested themes and deliverables for virtual meetings and phone calls
- Send reminder emails to connect with matches
- Highlight the work and accomplishments of matches

## Program timeline: August 2020 - 2021

- We are asking all mentors participating in this program for a minimum \$20

  student awards and scholarships.
- Mentors/Mentees are expected to meet virtually at least once per month
