The award focuses on interventions, and on ways of implementing them that differ from "one-size-fits-all," "one-size-largely-fits-all," or "almost fits all," approaches. The recipient's contribution can apply to community, residential, or institutional populations/environments within or outside of the United States. Nomination packets should include the nominee's name, affiliation, a CV, and a short description of relevant accomplishments.
